Sales & Service Tax (SST):

Starting 1st of July 2025, all private and international schools in Malaysia, including Stonyhurst International School Penang, are required to charge 6% SST on annual school fees exceeding RM 60,000 per pupil. This applies to all school fees, including tuition fee, Learning Support fee, Application and Enrolment fees (for new pupils only), and this will affect all pupils regardless of nationality, except Malaysian pupils with OKU cards who are exempted.
