FEES PAYABLE

1. Application Fee (Non-Refundable & Non-Transferable) - Payable Only Once

- 1.1 Primary (SJPPS) RM 300 per admission
- 1.2 Secondary (SJPSS) RM 300 per admission
- 1.3 International (SJIS) RM 500 per admission

Note: The Application Fee is only refundable when the School is unable to offer a place to a candidate.

- Per registration RM2,000

6.1 ADVANCE PAYMENT DISCOUNT:

A three percent (3%) discount will be given if the full year's school fees are paid by December for Primary and Secondary School, and by January for International School each year.

6.2 All fees can be paid at the School Office between **8:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon** and **2:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m.** on Monday to Friday (except for Public Holidays).

You do not have to inform us of the payment as JomPay will forward to us the payment information the next day.</i>

6.3 LATE PAYMENT CHARGE:

A five percent (5%) penalty will be imposed on all late payment.

6.4 A student who has not paid his/her fee together with all late payment charge(s) two weeks after the payment due date will not be allowed to attend classes until the said amount is fully settled.

6.5 Students who have been offered confirmed places must pay one term's school fee, which will be forfeited should the child withdraw.

6.6 Parents wishing to withdraw a student from school must give one (1) months' notice in writing of the intended withdrawal. Otherwise, an additional full term's fee will be charged.

6.7 Subject to paragraph 6.6 above, a student who leaves School before mid-term shall be eligible for refund of half a term's fee. A student who leaves after mid-term shall not be refunded of any portion of the school fee for the term.

6.8 The School board reserves the right to change and amend the fees payable as and when necessary.

6.9 The following items to be provided by the school at no extra charges:

- Course work materials
- Drawing block
- Examination pad
- Exercise books
- Printing papers for exercise, worksheets and tests
- Report card
- School Diary
